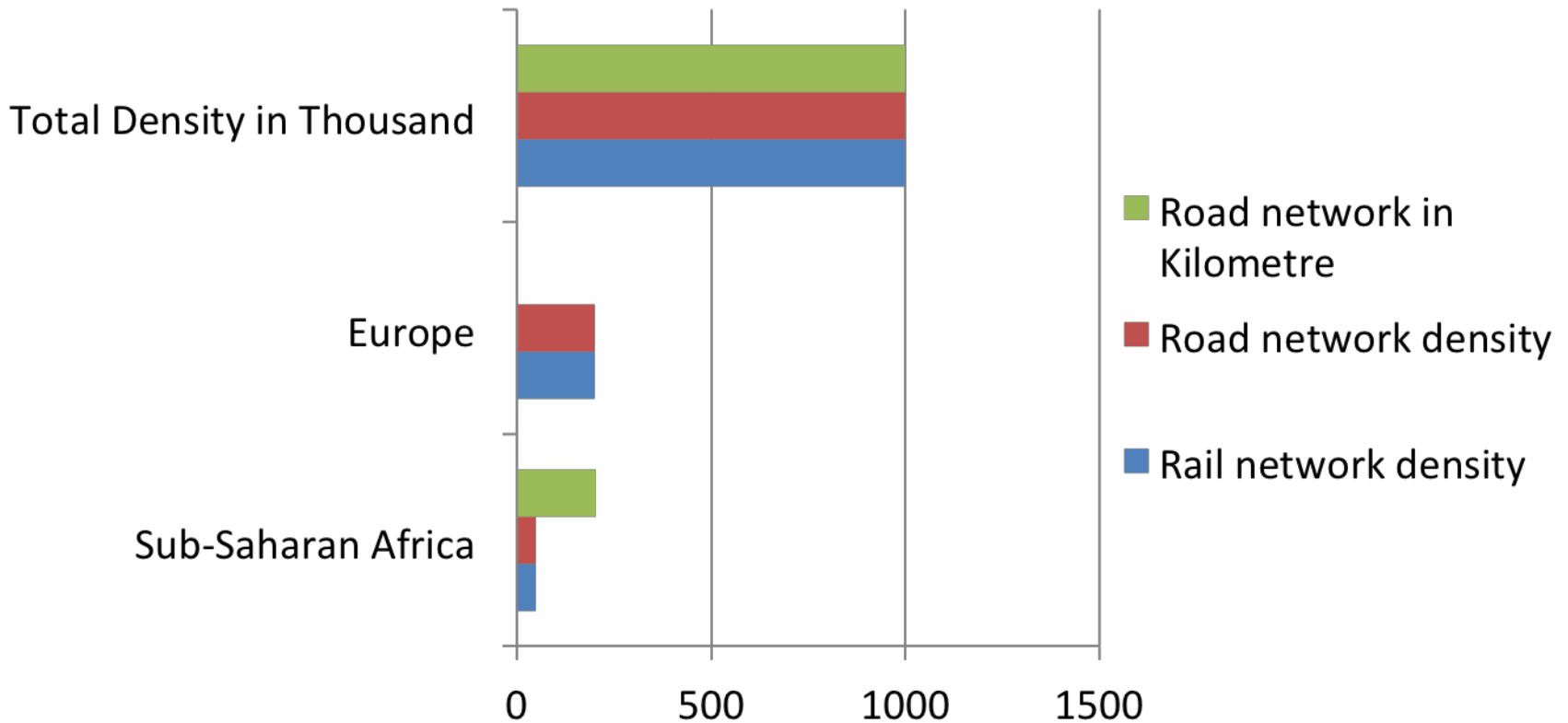

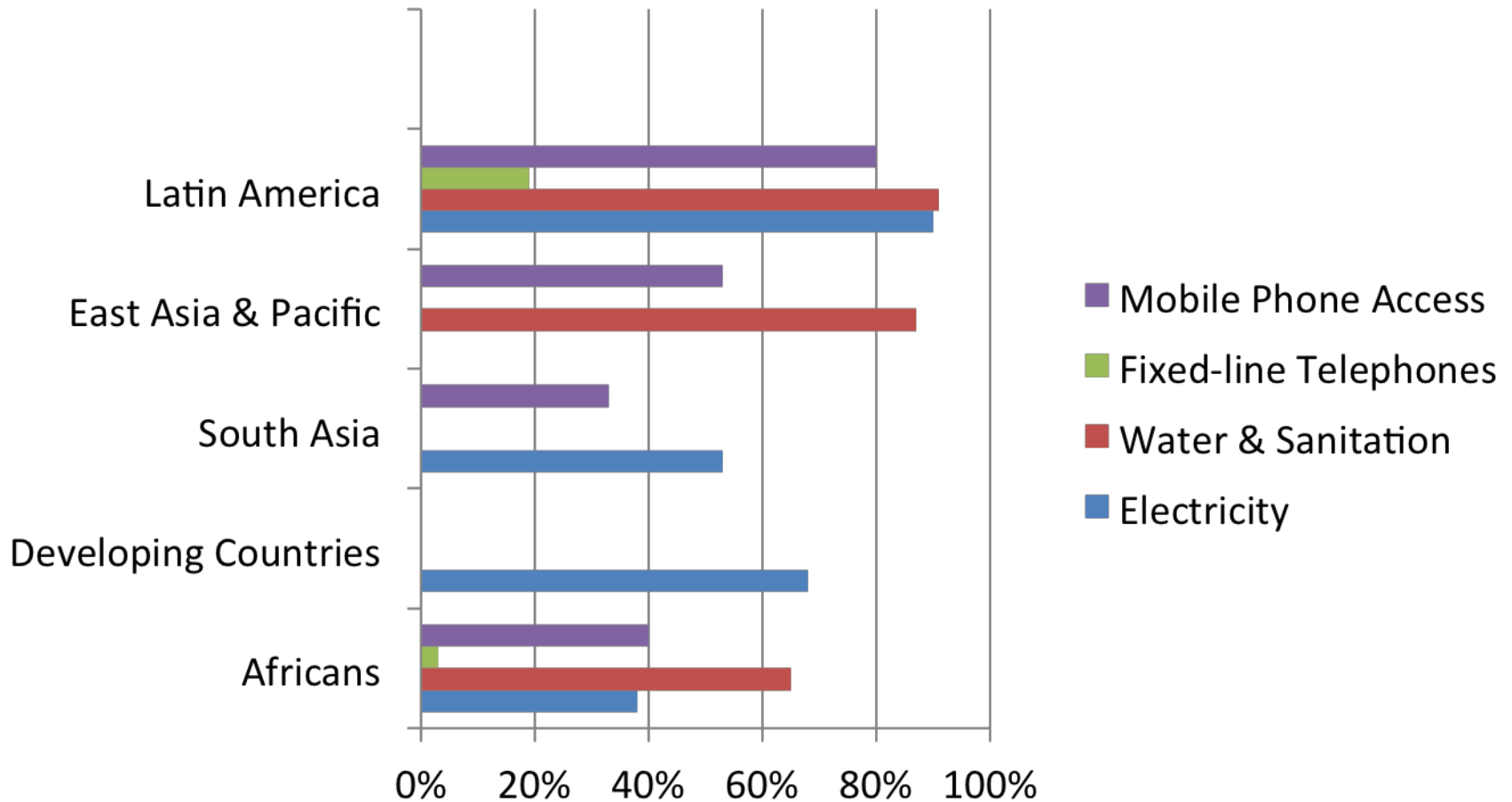

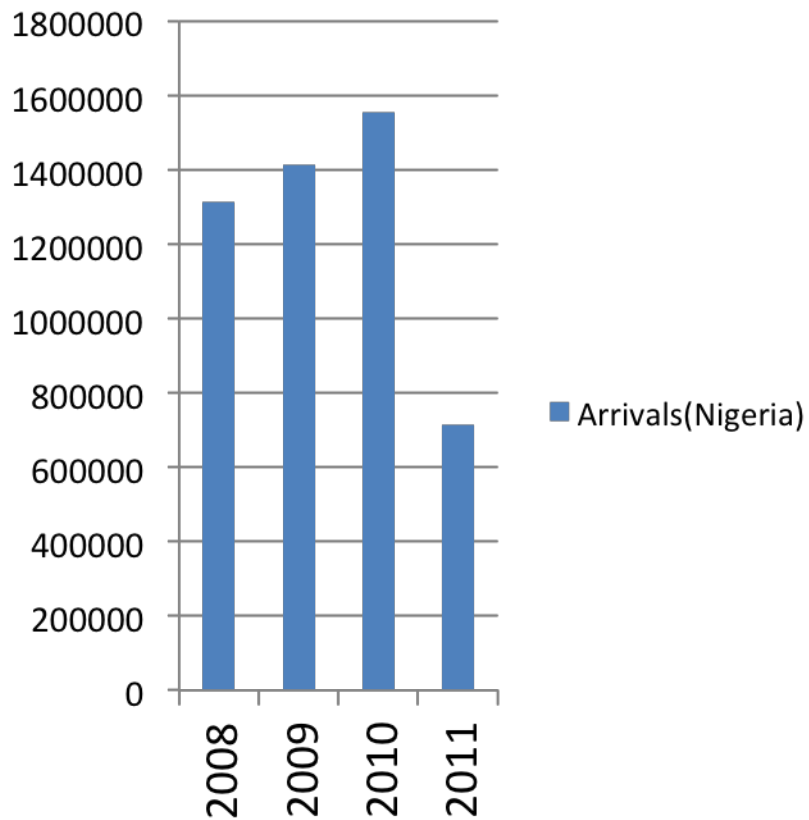
Current State of African Infrastructure- East Asia & Latin A



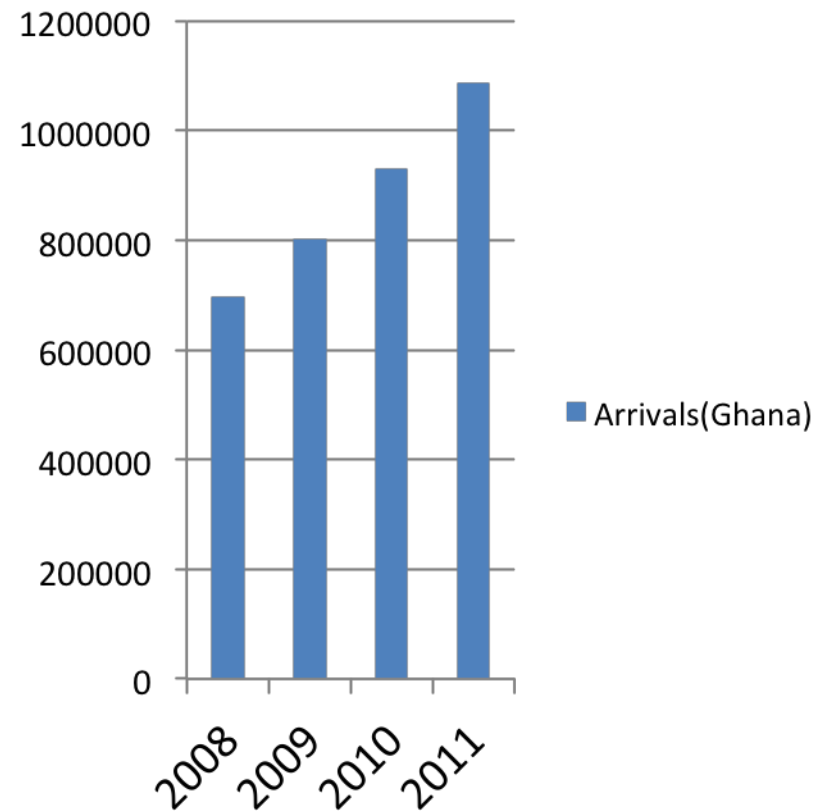

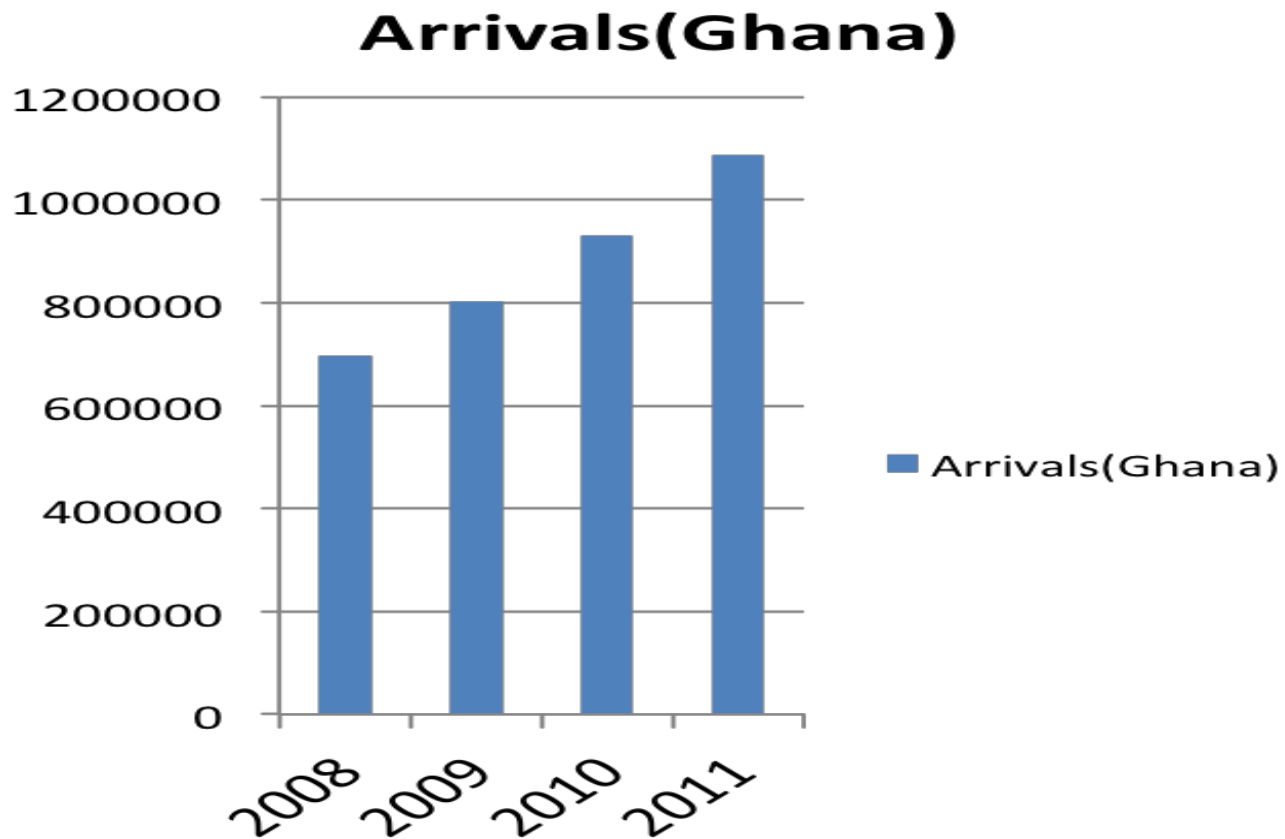

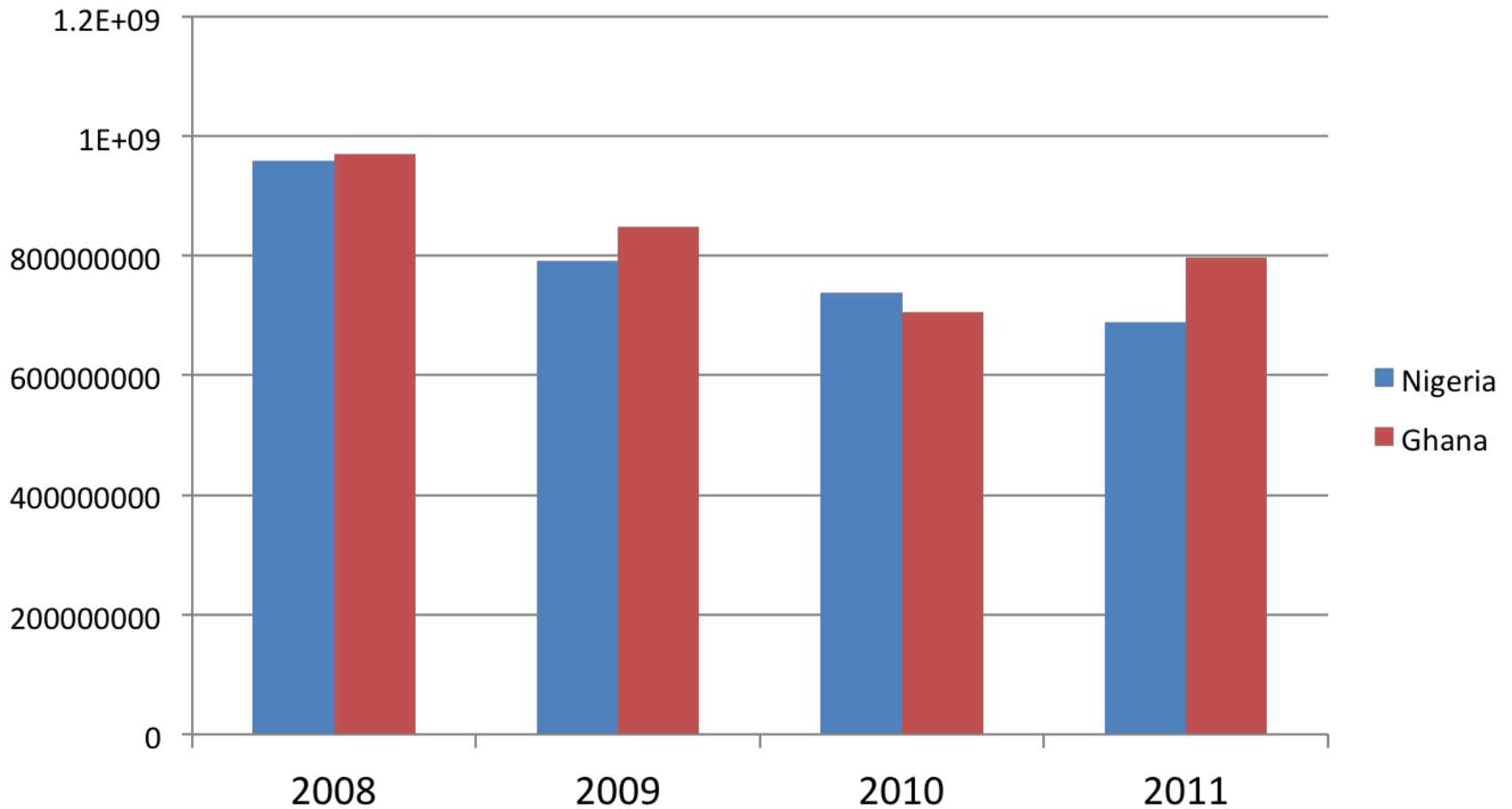

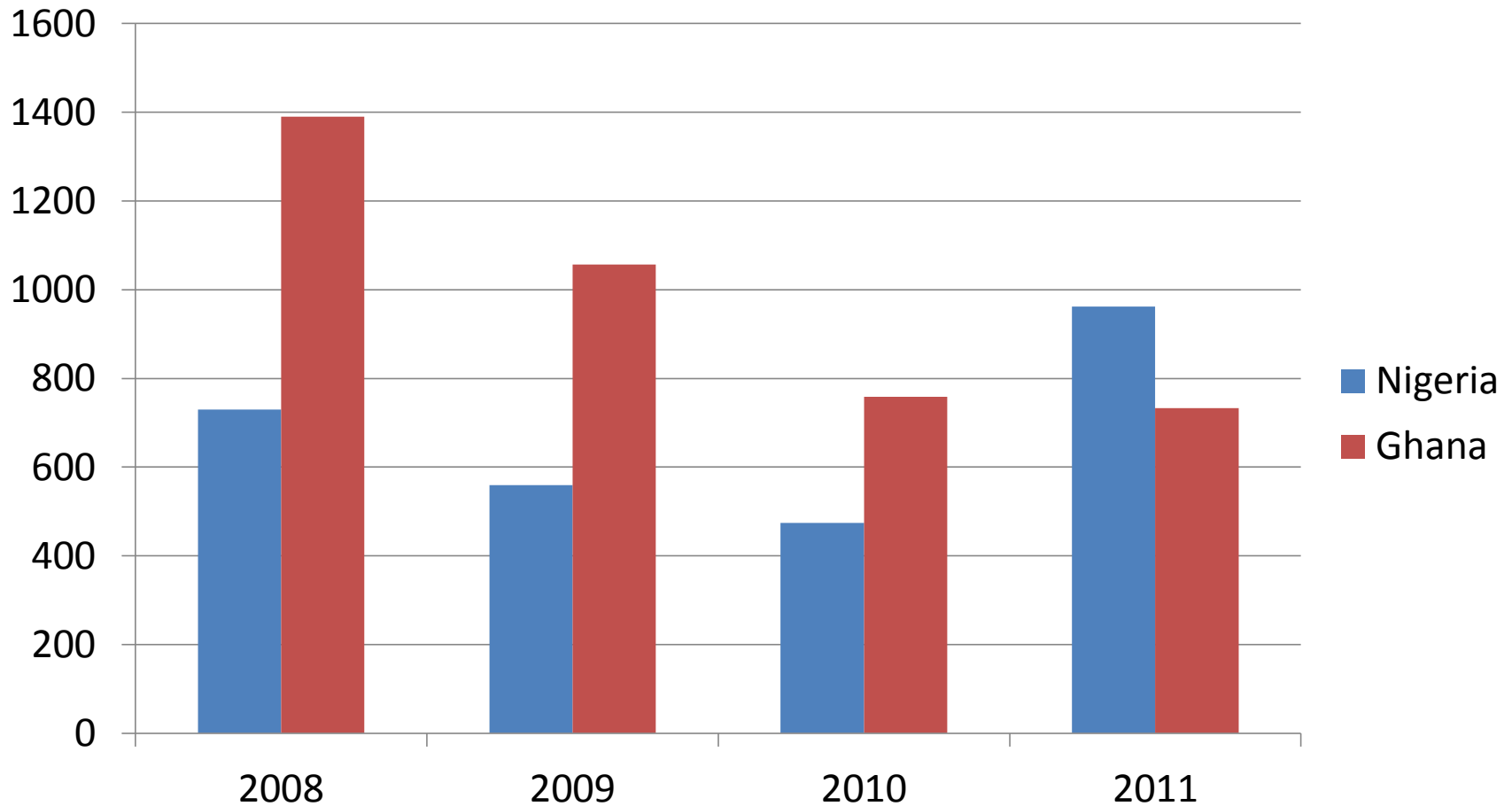

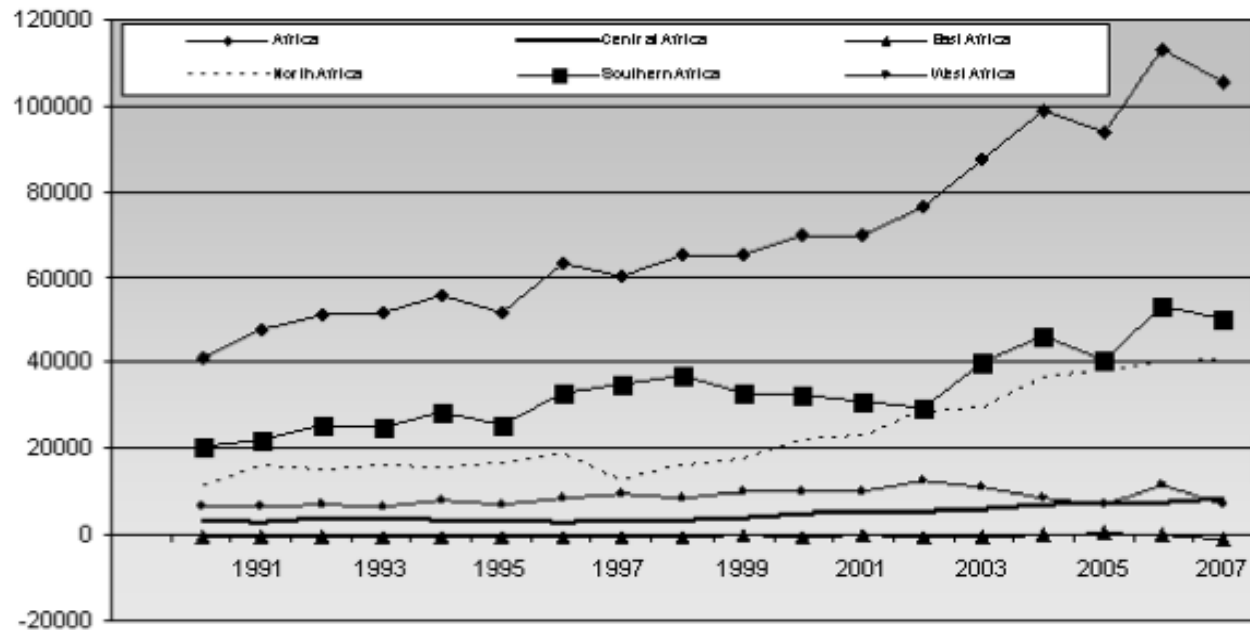

Regional Internet Density

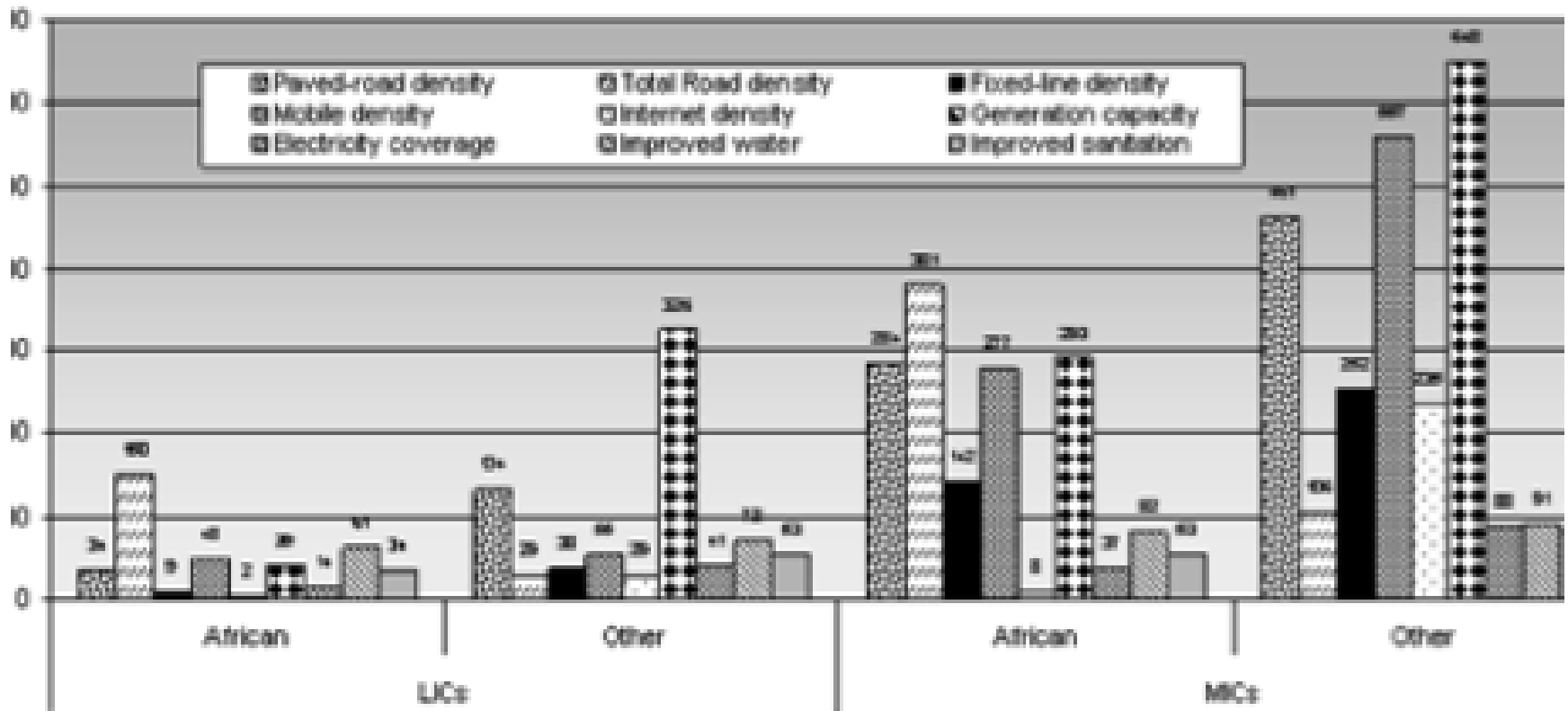
Figure 3: Regional Internet Users per 1000 Persons

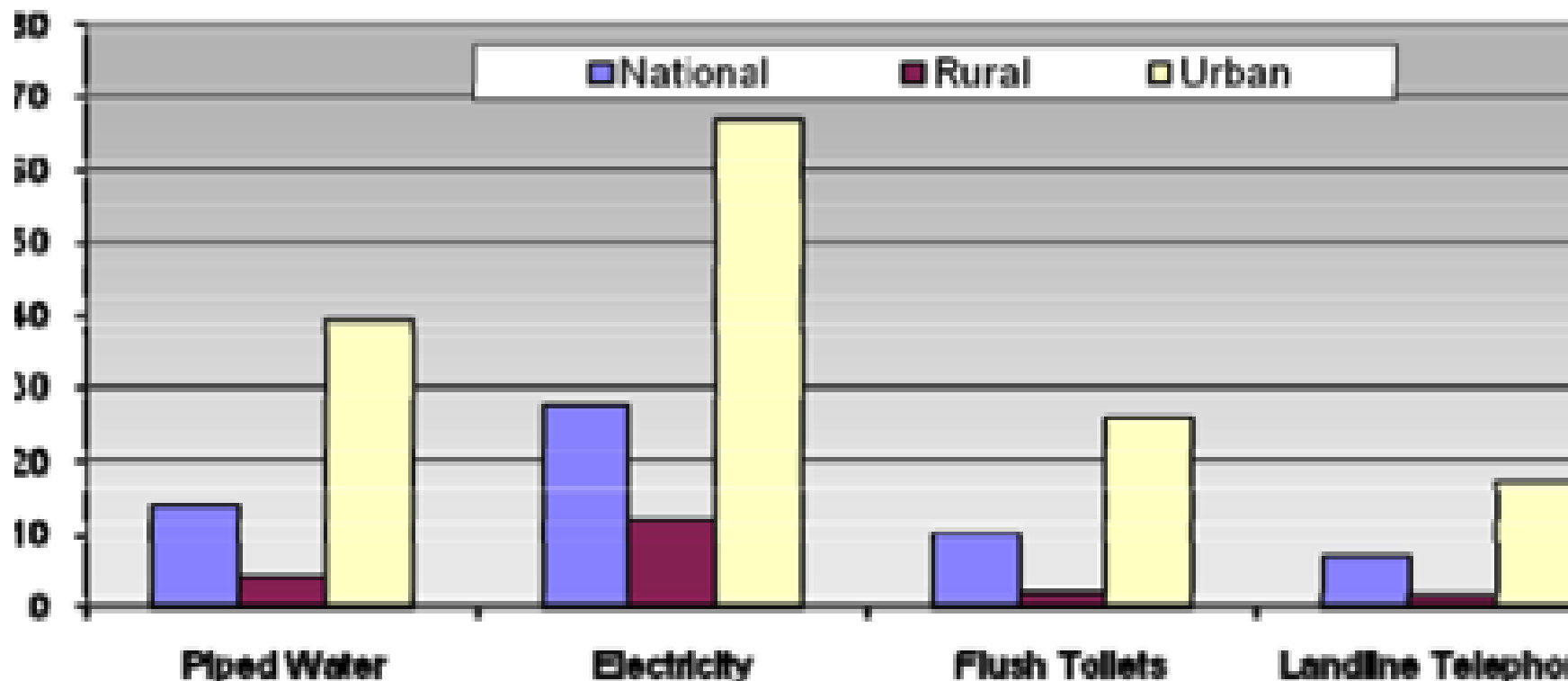
Figure 4: International Comparisons of Infrastructure Supply Conditions

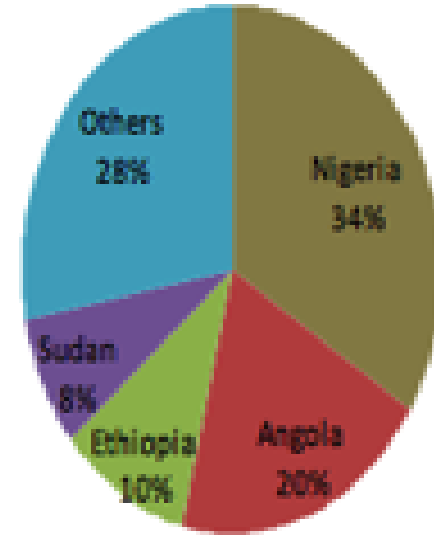
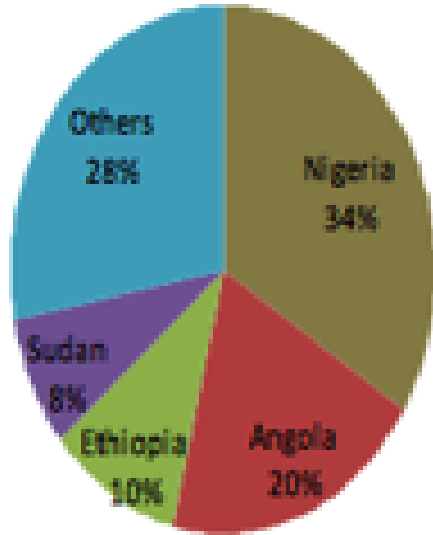

Figure 5: International Infrastructure Rural-urban Divide⁷



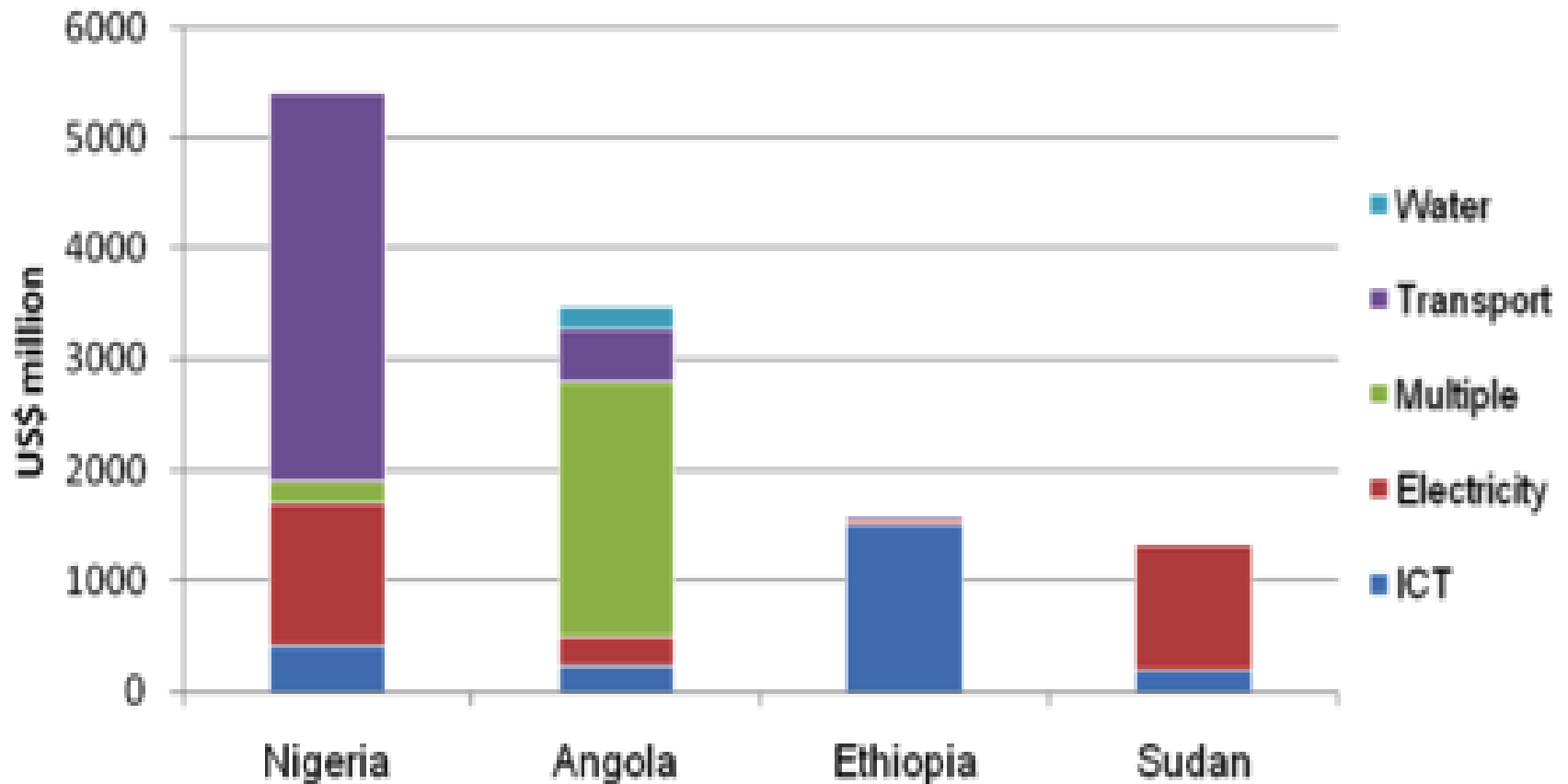
