- Writing research reports and investment ideas to be sent to clients;
- Ensuring that they meet the numerous compliance regulations;
- Maintaining regular communication with clients by telephone, email and in person, including updating fund managers/ hedge funds on investment ideas and summaries of research;
- Making presentations and recommendations as to which funds should be



included in fund managers' portfolios.
